BIBLE MILLS FOR EAST AFRICA



A Bible Mill is a maize Milling Machine which grinds maize into flour. People pay for the maize to be ground into flour and with the profit Bibles are bought for the new converts who live in the refugee camps or poor areas.

Thousands have come to Christ in East Africa and three Bible Mills are buying up to 80 Bibles a month.

The first three Bible Mills are situated in the Kakuma Refugee Camp, and in Garissa in Kenya and Raga in South Sudan.



Report from New Zealand Step Out In Faith Ministries

What a wonderful privilege to be able to help the church of Africa. To stand alongside Pastors and share resources with them and encourage them in the task they are doing.

It is an honour and brings great joy to be able to do this. I am always thankful to God for this amazing opportunity to be involved in this work.

The last three months of 2015 brought a great many challenges as the work increased and new plans for being able to keep up with the work, had to be made. This led to a greater reliance upon our Faithful God who gave me many new ways of doing things. I thank Him for His help in directing the work.

Trained 1047 Pastors

In the last three months we were able to train 1047 Pastors, who were taught how to run the Bible School and also how to do organic gardening. Each received their Bible School materials and Derek Prince books.

One training of 52 Pastors in Isiolo, when they all started their Bible Schools, between them they have 29,000 students. The number of students training in this area will have a large impact especially as they all go out to evangelise once a month. Praise God there will be a wonderful harvest of souls from this area.

35 Church plants

Due to the churches being filled to overflowing with so many new converts the only solution is to start new church plants. In the last three months of 2015 there were 35 new church plants started and each is running the Bible School in their churches. We provide the new Pastors with a full Bible. Many Pastors are having to start 2 or 3 new churches.

Full Bibles, 112 Given Out

What a privilege to be able to give to these new pastors a full Bible and also to the Leaders of the discipleship programs. We are so grateful to all the supporters here in NZ who help us be able to do this.

A Bible costs NZ \$10 and it becomes a most treasured possession of the Pastors and Leaders.

We also put in two more maize mills, one into Ethiopia and one in North Sudan. These mills provide a means of finances for the pastor to purchase more Bibles. Each month they can provide 50 to 80 New Testaments. This is a tremendous help to the Ministry when the Pastors can raise their own money for purchasing Bibles. We now have put in 5 maize mills for the purpose of purchasing Bibles. Two in Kenya, one in Ethiopia and two in Sudan. Thank you to all who helped us to be able to do this.

Boreholes for clean water

Many families have given a gift of clean water to a community, by paying for a borehole to go in, this helps the whole community. In the last three months we were able to put in 15 new boreholes and the Red Cross in the different countries gave the pump for each borehole. This is a legacy that keeps on giving throughout the years, as clean water improves the health of all the people and enables productive gardens to be grown. It prevents widows from being raped as they travel out from their community to get

water sometimes walking 6 to 8 hours in search of dirty water. Being able to have a water supply within their own community is such a great blessing. Here is one Pastor's response after the well was drilled and the water came up.

Sister Joy, from my heart I want to thank you and the sponsor who gave the money for our bore hole. Sincerely give this person our regards and appreciation for their passion.

When the water came out we were as if we were dreaming, that day many people from all corners of the community came to see the miracle and we had the opportunity to preach salvation, 79 souls came to Jesus Christ.

During this day when the water came up, many people especially the men praised God because their wives and daughters were being raped on their way to look for water. But for now this has ceased and the men are not travelling a long distance to let their flocks have a drink. WE ARE SAYING A BIG THANK YOU AND MAY GOD BLESS YOU.

Land for displaced widows

During the trouble in Eldoret in 2007 many people lost their lives and many were displaced from off their land. There was a group of 867 widows who had lost their husbands in the tribal war and lost their homes and land.

The good news is that with the Government helping, and the Chief, and Governor, and the widows contribution, along with sponsor gifts, we have been able to make the final payment on the land for the widows.

Each will own their own parcel of land that is registered in their names. They can erect a dwelling for them to live in and grow their own gardens to feed themselves. They have all been taught on how to make composts to improve the soils.

This is the hand of God helping these widows whom He cares about so much.

NEWS FROM THE UK

We are so thankful for your partnership and support in different ways, especially prayer for the ministry is so important. We are also so grateful to 'Derek Prince Ministries' who partner with us in providing the 'Life Changing Spiritual Power' and the 'Self Bible Study Course' books by Derek Prince to thousands of our pastors.

The radio ministry has grown. Due to many thousands listening in every Sunday morning in Liberia at 7am and Sierra Leone at 8 am, we are given extra slots free of charge. In Sierra Leone I now speak 9pm Sunday evenings as well covering subjects like overcoming the prosperity cult, true and false prophesy etc. The whole of the Bible School of evangelism is now being taught over the radio every Sunday as well as the extra slots during the week.

Regular weekly preaching to new villages in Pakistan hear of people healed with every phone call. People come to Christ weekly due to Jesus healing the sick. Last week a lady who was dying was instantly healed. A paralysed 12 year old girl could suddenly get up and walk. People brought to the meeting on stretchers were also healed.

The Bible Schools of evangelism continue to grow steadily. In some countries the growth is small and other countries the growth is doubling or tripling every year. We are now looking to get the courses translated into the more needed languages and put on our website to be downloaded by the teachers or students. We hope to start on this very soon.

Teaching healing and prayer weeks or weekends continue monthly at Erw Coed in North Wales and once a year at the Ranch.
