

Thank you all so much for your support during 2014 making it our best year so far! Your support has enabled over 30,000 evangelists to graduate this year, feed our orphans in Pakistan, enabled self sufficiency in various countries and reached a huge number of people by radio in Africa.

Revival has broken out in various parts of Africa. In Kenya, under Joy Johnsons work, 2,200 Prisoners came to the Lord and were baptised in a prison in Mombasa. It took all day for eleven pastors to baptise them all. Revival has also broken out in the refugee camps in the Refugee camps in Kenya and bible schools have been opened there. The students also did door to door evangelism every month as part of their studies and brought 18,310 people to the Lord between them.

Breaking Through The Impossible With Christ: In Sierra Leone, West Africa, Pastor Bobor has just completed two more journeys, one through central Sierra Leone and one to the South of Sierra Leone. This time not to take authority over Ebolo Virus as there is none in the eleven towns where we took authority over the virus in Jesus name. This time it was to encourage the Revival that has broken out as a result of the Lord delivering their towns from the deadly virus.

Most churches with a congregation of 50 people have grown to 150 or 200 people in two months. Almost daily I have spoken by phone to packed Gospel Crusades and by radio once or twice a day in those bigger towns that have radio stations. The people are so excited because they have all seen the great power of God over the Ebolo Virus.

Pastor Bobor was also invited to New Guinea, where he attached his speaker to his generator in the car and advertised a crusade for everybody to come to a certain selected field one hour later. Hundreds of people came. I gave the gospel message through the phone and an interpreter translated the message into French. Many people received Christ as a result. We then took authority over the Ebolo Virus in that town.

On the way back from Guinea, Bobor's car had a broken back axel, so he had to walk the last ten miles. During the four days it took to get the axel fixed, I was able to preach over the radio twice a day to teach the basics of Christianity and spoke at a crusade every evening. This encouraged the Revival in that town.

Though the media is reluctant to report any good news, the people on the ground know that God has done it.



Summary of the East Africa Work in 2014, by Joy Johnson

Bible School work

- * 202 Bible Schools started in Kenya in 2014
- * 32 Bible Schools started in Somalia, Ethiopia, and Sudan in 2014
- * 17,000 students were trained in Evangelism in these Bible Schools.

* 18,310 New converts have joined the churches. Many churches have grown from 40 members to 350-500 members, as a result of the monthly outreaches with the students.

* 2,500 Prisoners gave their lives to Christ, of which 1,800 were Muslim. 2,200 were baptised in November 2014 in the Mombasa prison.

* In 4 Refugee camps in Kenya evangelistic work has begun, Dabaab, Bravan, Kakuma, Karacha camps. Hundreds are turning to Christ and being discipled. 1,012 baptised in Dabaab in December 2014.

Widows training

* 8,603 Widows trained in organic gardening to improve their soils so they can grow better crops.

* They also attend the Bible Schools set up for widows in their areas and many are receiving Jesus.

Water

* 40 Boreholes have been dug for Kenyan communities to provide clean water and to enable good gardens in the desert areas. These protect the widows from being raped.

* 13 Boreholes have been dug in Somalia, Ethiopia, and Sudan. Women were collecting water by walking 6 to 8 hours to a water supply. Therefore a borehole in their own community provides safety for the women

* 5 Water tanks have been installed in 4 schools for orphans in different provinces in Uganda

School building work

* 2 Toilet blocks have been built for two schools for orphans in Kenya.

* 4 School classroom blocks, with 3 classrooms in each block, have been built with bricks and iron roofing for schools for orphans in 4 provinces in Uganda: Kasese, Kyenjojo, Kibaale, Mubende.
