Samantha Jackson also competed and made it to the national championship finals at Stoneliegh to ride with the 100 top juniors of the country. Well done Samantha.

We thank the churches who gave generously towards the overseas crusades, Bicycle Ministry in Kenya and Uganda and TV evangelism in Ghana and Nigeria. Without your support financially and in prayer we could not have done it. Please carry on praying.

We are also prepared to speak in churches and are taking bookings for speaking Engagements now, for the rest of the year and next year.

### Uganda & Kenya Bicycle Ministry

The Lord reveals to me, that I am to reach the small villages that have not yet heard the gospel. "That would take me two lifetimes" I reply.

Then God shows me how. Within one week, He raises up 20 Evangelists in Uganda and 30 Evangelists in Kenya ready to take the gospel into the small rural villages. All they need is a bicycle to get there and a megaphone to call in the people to listen and hear the word of God.

Already the first bicycles have been sent and the Bicycle Ministry is already in operation. Not only that it has already spread to the rainforest villages of Ghana and Nigeria "Why has no one thought to do this before" I ask the Lord.

This is directly from the Lord and I would not have thought of it either, I simply heard the Lord and obeyed and it is He alone, who is causing all this to happen.



#### Cities Ghana & Nigeria TV Evangelism

Three days of Crusades are cancelled. I did not go to Nigeria to sit around. I ask to speak anywhere, and speak at a prison and a high school.

On the way back from the school the Lord says turn around and go to the TV people. I return to the school the camera men have left. The Lord says "not here" go to the TV Studio. We go. We are told to meet the special editions manager. He is a Christian and invites me to speak live 8am next morning and to do a I hour broadcast on Monday 9am. Both include the gospel.

Message, prayer of salvation and prayer for the sick to be shown in 9 states in Nigeria at no cost.

Following these two broadcasts, we have four sermons including prayer for salvation and healing of 45 minuets to be shown between now and Christmas in Nigeria. Two 1 hour broadcasts are also to be shown on nation wide national TV in Ghana.

Only the Lord could have opened such doors to reach the millions, rather

than the thousands that He had allowed to be cancelled.
