Update in mission trip to: GHANA, TOGO and LIBERIA

This Outreach is to go into another 6 regions, 4 in Ghana plus Liberia and Togo to open up new training chapters for the Bible School and Bicycle Ministry. Pastors from all denominations gather together for 3 days of training and introduction to the Bible School in 5 areas.

We are taken around to see the dire need for evangelism and the different situations. Everywhere we are welcomed with excitement, as in every case, this is the first chance to receive any training, simply because they have no money. This Bible School is free of charge! Romans 10:14 "But how are they to call on Him in whom they have not believed, and how are they to believe in Him of whom they have never heard, and how are they to hear without someone preaching? How are they to preach unless they are sent? As it is written, "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news."

DELTA This verse has come so alive, as I see the reality of it in front of me. The Word of God has already reached every city and town in Africa, but what about the villages? In the Delta region, the large Delta River provides thousands of fishermen with a living. They live in small villages along the river banks. There are no roads at all to them, simply because canoes are their only means of transport. These people have never yet had the Gospel preached in their villages. With training and a boat, the church will be able to evangelise all these villages and plant churches in them.

WA In Wa, far north of Ghana is yet another situation. This area is sparsely populated with small villages a good 25 miles apart, set in typical African bush *veld* with beautiful yellow grasslands. These people still live off the African game that roam free. Some of the larger villages were reached with the Gospel by missionaries, though most missionaries never survived beyond two years due to sicknesses. A few Methodist Churches still remain, but are empty because when the Moslems came from the North, all the people became Moslems.

We travel 23 hours to reach this area, covered in a thick red dust from the gravel roads. It is a joy to receive a bucket of water to bath, wash hair and clothing and to fall into a real bed!

Next morning, still exhausted from the journey squashed up in the mini bus and the extreme heat, I call out to God in tears, claiming the three villages we are to visit that day for Him in Jesus' Name. Then I pray that 3 churches will be planted today in Jesus' name!
