We then leave to watch how Jesus will do it: in the first village near Wa, 300 people including the Chief accept Jesus as Lord and Saviour and with joy I re-dedicate the derelict church to the Lord and the first church is planted. In the second village 49 people receive Jesus as Lord and Saviour. Here the people have never heard the gospel before, yet a church ends up being planted.

We then drive a long way to the flat mud-roofed homes of the third village, where 600 receive Jesus as Lord and dance with joy at the offer of a church being planted in their midst. The Bible School is welcomed by the church of Wa. They also need a motorbike to get to the villages.

We then drive back to Wa through a thunderstorm enjoying the cooler sweet-smelling rain. We are given 30 minutes to eat and change so as to catch the bus for our next 23 hour drive through the night and next day to our next region.

PRAYER ÇAMP 28 long hours later, we reach 'Bethlehem Prayer Camp' near the Togo border. It's 9pm. We are shown into a tin roofed, mud building by candlelight and fall gratefully into bed in a very hot room. Next morning we are shown around many thatched, mud prayer-huts; this is where normally around 500 people stay when coming for the Lord to heal them. They fast for three days and normally go home healed and the next group come in.

We are then taken to Jericho, a grassy area with a wide path round it. In the middle, I am shocked to see people chained to the trees. "There are no mental asylums in Ghana," prophet Elijah explains. "The mentally deranged, demon possessed and murderers are sent to prayer camps. We have to chain them, they are dangerous, some will kill everyone they see." "So why do you chain them here?" I ask. "You see this path," he explains, "Twice a day all 500 villagers come here. They march round Jericho seven times praying twice a day and this causes the demons to leave!" "You mean", I ask, "that the demons are so afraid of praying Christians, that as the people can't run since they are chained, the demons run out of the people?" "Yes, and they are free and can go home" he explains simply. Here I am left struggling with my theology a bit, but after watching Elijah free a couple of these people, and having heard their powerful testimonies that evening, my faith begins to rise more and more to the power of prayer and the wonderful power of God. For between 3 days and a maximum of 4 weeks, these demon-possessed, deranged, mad people were totally and completely delivered, set free and healed to go home as sane normal people! "Elijah, I would rather be chained to a tree for 4 weeks than spend a lifetime in a mental asylum in the West with tablets to merely subdue the symptoms, if I had the misfortune to be one of them," I said.

Elijah has already built the Bible School classrooms, and has 50 evangelists waiting to do Bible School, but is trusting God to send the actual Bible School material somehow. So when I tell him I have the Bible School notes to give them, he dances around thanking God for answering his prayer and, by the afternoon, I find myself teaching the first lesson of Step Out In Faith Bible School to 50 eager students in their newly built classroom.

Hugh Bettles also joins us here from Liberia. He has planted the Bible School and Bicycle ministry there and David Blotchway has done the same in Togo and we all return to Accra together. Altogether another 6 Bible Schools are planted on this trip!

The USA. Heatstroke and diarrhoea has attacked me and, after flying home to England, I end up in hospital for a week with typhoid fever. I have lost almost a stone in weight and the doctors are saying I should not fly to the USA! But I have been invited to speak on the TV Harvest Show and am determined to go. Now out of hospital I manage to eat on Saturday and, by 3.30am, I am ready to go. I manage to convince Wilfrid that I am well enough to fly. The Lord heals me completely on the way. On Tuesday at 7.30am I am taken to the TV studios. After a professional make-up in the beautiful lounge that makes me feel a bit like Joyce Meyers, I am led into the largest studio with hundreds of cameras. Looking up to the TV screen I suddenly see my book, 'Dare To Enter His Presence' on the TV screen with the announcement "and at 9.30 we interview the author Suzanne Pillans on how to come into the presence of God." 'Is this why I am here? My book?'

The interview goes very well as the Holy Spirit gave me every word. (My book was a feature book and stayed in the top 10 for 3 weeks. Only God could do that.) Copies of this broadcast are available from us on request. The rest of the trip also goes well at Voice Ministries and Faith Ranch, Ohio and we also open our USA office and bank account at Faith Ranch under the direction of Linda Maxwell.

In South Africa we reach out to the youth, see healings and speak on national radio.

The Lord has made all this possible. All we need to do, you and I, is obey the Lord in the area He tells us and He does all the rest. You and I are a team, together in prayer, for sending forth His evangelists in Africa to do His work. Thank-you friends, thank-you Lord!
