The harvest is plentiful but the laborers are few.

If I had not responded to this work it would have been left undone, but God wants us to reach the lost and so prompted me to respond to this invitation.

Please pray with me for three great days of Evangelism, that many may come to know Jesus as their Lord and Savior.

The Bicycle Ministry has taken off. In Malawi alone there are three new churches planted, Liuhwide, Sathawa and Nomboro with the total of 2006 new converts.

Pastor Tennyso Munya writes. 'Pastor Suzanne you left a very big task here I am making sure that the goal is done. Please as the ministry is becoming big it lacks a number of things.

1. Stationary. 2. Office equipment. There is also a big problem of scarcity of bibles in the planted churches where the whole church may have one rugged bible. Please consider these things.. Thank you, Pastor Tennyso Munm.

We have also reroofed the church in Samuti Village which cost two hundred and fifty to rebuild the church using cement instead of mud to keep the bricks in place and to put on a tin roof on new rafters. Pastor John Chimwaye and his six church plants numbering over 1.654 became Christians in December having turned from worshiping Nimrod to Christ.

In Kenya we are roofing five churches. In Ghana one church for the rain forest area at the request from the king., and in Bulgaria one church which is to serve six villages. That is a total of ten churches.
