

## 95 Graduates in Uganda

What a joyful welcome to the church. Many people had prayed for years for this opportunity for training. One man has run a church since 2000 and last year in 2006 he said the Lord answered his prayer with the Bible School to equip him for this work.

Some people walked 17 kilometres and one person 23 kilometres each

but this was included in the course. Now they can read and write, preach & witness for Jesus with confidence. It was quite overwhelming to give them the talk as I saw so clearly God's hand in everything He is accomplishing. The evangelists then gave testimonies and received their certificates. One young man was so overjoyed that he was leaping in the air. He said it was the best day in his life up to now. They all gave thanks to the Lord then to you our sponsors who have made all this possible. Thank you from Uganda.

## International Conference

We spoke at two international conferences. A five day conference in Kampala Uganda and a five day conference in Bala Kenya. Though the numbers attending both conferences were less than expected 51 new Bible Schools were planted; 20 in Uganda and 31 in Kenya.

We also worked in wonderful unity with the international team from the USA, Australia & other countries: Gary Pembeton and Bill Behrmann from the USA; Howard Sands, Joel & Paul from Australia; Jerome and myself from England along with other speakers from East Africa. We also spoke in many churches around Kampala.

## Difficulties Solved

One problem is that after some evangelists have planted 3 churches

they end up having to pastor them as there are no pastors. Some bicycles therefore end up having to be used to get to the 3 churches rather than evangelising new villages. The only way to solve this problem is to have a second

years training for a pastor's certificate to release more evangelists to plant more churches.

Here again the Lord has led by a visit of IMF who went through the syllabus with myself and Jerome Lucas who has offered to put together pastoral care to complete the syllabus. We aim to begin the pastor's certificate in January 2008.

We have also improved our checks with the pastor of each country, taping each bicycle with a GB and a number, to avoid misuse of any bicycle.

We welcome people to come with us on these trips. Almost with every trip now we take at least 1 person. These people often become a vital part in our ministry in one way or another. Seeing the wonderful work the Lord is doing changes one's life. Jerome Lucas joined us on this trip and enjoyed every moment. We also gave out an extra 85 Bibles and 10 bicycles on the trip.
