## Telephone Evangelism

How do you visit 23,000 evangelists? Jesus has the answer – by phone.

Every day Suzanne is teaching students in 2 day teaching conferences in Uganda, Pakistan or India or speaking in outreaches to remote villages, all by phone.

Suzanne says, 'You can actually see where the students are spiritually by their vocal response. If they go silent you know they are struggling, with sin or unbelief. I then work in that area.

In Uganda a bible school was struggling to believe the Lord could heal them. I asked those who needed to be baptised in the Holy Spirit to stand. Most stood. After they were baptised in the Holy Spirit, I told those who were sick to lay their own hands on their sickness and tell the sickness to go in Jesus' name. Only two received healing and testified. I told the rest of them to sort themselves out with God in prayer and if they did believe that Jesus is Lord and receive healing that they would be healed and I ended the call. Four hours later, they phoned to say that the evangelists did sort themselves out in prayer and as a result every person received their healing.

Another time, speaking on the Armour of God to the Congo, the phone went dead near the end of the talk. A few hours later Edward phoned to apologise, saying that the Holy Spirit had come down on the whole bible school and everyone fell on their faces on the floor in repentance.

About two phone calls everyday and Jesus does the rest. He is preparing evangelists to go out, not just to preach the gospel but also to demonstrate that Jesus is alive. Every phone call is met by Jesus healing the sick. All I can do is praise Him.
