- 3) In Rawand Village Mushag had a skin problem and was in a very bad condition. He said, "if your God will not heal me then please I want to die." God healed him.
- 4) Warise had a stone in his right kidney. When we asked those who were sick to stand up, he stood up crying and received his healing and said "pastor I am healed".
- 5) Azhra had a tumour in her forehead. As we prayed over the phone the tumour disappeared. She was so happy and shouted "Hallelujah, Hallelujah!!"

Arif says he is so thankful for the teachings over the phone and about the armour of God. He Said 'The breastplate of righteousness is powerful by the grace of God. Newcomer pastors told us that now they will walk in righteousness from God'.

The devastating floods have washed away 3 Bible Schools completely with generator, keyboard, and 40 chairs. We are raising money to try and replace this loss.

Another Healing testimony from New Zealand

In 2009 a young high school girl had a rare sickness causing great pain with any physical touch and also prevented her walking or running so she had to use crutches. This sickness prohibited her from living a normal life for several years.

When Suzanne prayed for her at Rangiora Baptist Church, she got up without crutches and walked across the floor. Suzanne said "run", and she did. Completely healed! She walked out of the church, her friend holding up her crutches high in the air. She testified to her school the next day and now in 2010 is still testifying of God's miracle power that touched her and healed her instantly. A true miracle from God.
